

The regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Stamford was held on July 8, 2020 at 7:00 P.M. at the Town of Stamford Municipal Building with the following present:

A MOTION was made by David Post and seconded by Daniel Deysenroth to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. ALL AYE votes cast, MOTION carried.

Sam Maltese and Maureen McKay were present looking for support from the community. Sam Maltese and his brother own and operate the Dinner Plate, a restaurant located in the Village of Hobart, Town of Stamford. Their landlord gave them two months to vacate the rented restaurant with the reason that he looking to open bookstores and a high-end martini bar at that location. The board sympathized with their situation and suggested they attend the Village of Hobart and Village of Stamford's board meetings. The Dinner Plate is located in the Village of Hobart and any zoning issues would be governed by them. Mr. Maltese and his brother own a building in the Village of Stamford which they would like to renovate into a restaurant which poses a financial hardship. The Dinner Plate is floating a petition to try to stay open in Hobart with approximately 100 signatures so far.

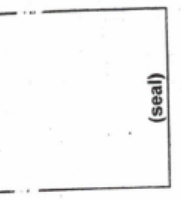
