Mike Cairns, Operator for the LVDV Operations, Inc. for the South Kortright Sewer District has reviewed the year to date expenditure reports and presented the board a draft proposed 2021 budget and overview.

LVDV Operations, Inc. has reviewed YTD expenditure reports for the Town of Stamford, South Kortright and Allen Center provided by Supervisor John Kosier. Attached please find a proposed O&M Budget for 2021. We have made adjustments to the budget resulting in an increase of \$9485 (11.1%), noted as follows:

1)Personnel/O&M Operator- increased by \$4785 from 32,390 to \$37,175 (14.8%). \$35,300 for basic services per operations contract plus budgeted \$1875 (25 hours per year) for additional services (emergency call outs)

2)O&M/Preventative maintenance and service contracts- increased by \$600 (66.7%). The Hamlet generator service increased from \$900 to \$1000 (11%) (see quote from Power Generations) plus \$600 for sludge removal at the Hamlet pump station based on the billing from Dan's Septic Service for sludge removal at the Allen Center wet well in 2020 (see bill from Dan's Septic Service)

3)Collection System O&M/Repairs- increased by \$1000 (200%) based on known repair cost in 2019.

4)Allen Center Station Cost/Generator service- for the Allen Center generator increased by \$100 (9%) as per quote from Power Generations.

5)Allen Center Cost/Potassium permanganate- increased by \$3000 (25%) based on expenditures to date of \$7710.46 through June, and the projected use through the end of 2020.
