The meeting was CALLED TO ORDER at 6:00 PM and started with the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by Jake Palmatier and second by Jessica Watson to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. ALL AYE votes cast, MOTION carried.

A MOTION was made by Julie Sechrist, and second by Jake Palmatier to approve the Supervisor’s monthly report ALL AYE votes cast, MOTION carried.

A MOTION was made by John Kosier and second by Jake Palmatier to approve General Bills A2630-A2645 for a total of \$ 9459.99 and General Fund B2603 total of \$3054.18, and SL 2603 for \$84.26 ALL AYE votes cast, MOTION carried.

A MOTION was made by Jessica Watson and second by Julie Sechrist to approve Highway Fund DA abstracts DA2612-2618 total of \$4861.15, Highway DB2604-2605 total of \$15,683.47 ALL AYE votes cast, MOTION carried.

A MOTION was made by Julie Sechrist and second by Debora Ballard to approve South Kortright Sewer District bills, abstract SK2605-2610 for a total \$12,961.27 ALL AYE votes cast, MOTION carried.

Mike from LVDV spoke on the Knight sewer project, they are currently on steps #4 and #5, and the O&M budgets fo 2027 seeing an increase of 3.2%.

Dan Miglianti, highway supervisor, spoke to his CHIPS schedule and will be submitting a final need shortly. There was mention of Foote Hollow Road bridge repair needs, and John said he would reach out to Soil and Water for more information on funding. Roses Brook bridge, nea Miglianti property is in need of repair, and the Mattice Road Colvert needs attention, all on Dan’s agenda to be prioritized. A truck was in need of repair, and parts bought from Henderson Products, and Gilees Auto, explaining the large purchases in HWY DA and DB.

Cemetery Mowing bids will be published in the town paper, as we have 8 cemeteries in our town that will need attention. They will be opened and decided on April 8, 2026 meeting. Motion for the newspaper to publish the bid ad was made by Jessica Watson, and seconded by Julie Sechrist.

The port-a-john will be delivered in May for the Farmers Market, donated by the town.

A motion was made by John Kosier and seconded by Julie Sechrist for the Noise Ordinance **RESOLUTION 6-2026**, and will be duly adopted as the state returns paperwork.

Cameras for live feed of Town Board Meetings were ordered, and anticipated to be up and running in April 8, 2026 meeting.
