

The regular monthly meeting of the Town of Stamford was held on June 10, 2026 at 6:00pm, at the Town of Stamford Municipal Building with the following present

The meeting was CALLED TO ORDER at 6:00 pm with the Pledge of Allegiance.

A MOTION was made by Julie Sechrist and seconded by Jake Palmatier to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. ALL AYES votes cast, MOTION carried.

A MOTION was made by Jessica Watson, and seconded by Jake Palmatier to approve the Supervisors monthly report, ALL AYES votes cast, MOTION carried.

A MOTION was made by Julie Sechrist and seconded by Jake Palmatier to approve General Bills Abstract A2680-A2694 for a total of \$31,161.34 and General Fund B2607 for a total of \$3,054.18 and SL2606 for a total of \$81.58
ALL AYES vote cast, MOTION carried.

A MOTION was made by Julie Sechrist and seconded by Jake Palmatier to approve Highway Fund DA2631-DA2636 for a total of \$32,895.61. Highway DB2610-DB2611 for a total of \$35,393.04.
ALL AYES vote cast, MOTION carried.

A MOTION was made by Julie Sechrist and seconded by Jessica Watson to approve the South Kortright Sewer District bills SK2617-SK2621 for a total of \$9,833.93. ALL AYES vote cast, MOTION carried.

Highway Supervisor, Dan Miglianti gave a highway report, the 2008 MACK needed a new windshield. Ditching in the town is going to schedule, and we are able to help surrounding towns as needed. Town Supervisor John Kosier is going to follow up with Soil & Water of our needs for Foote Hollow bridge.

Brian Dengler was appointed a new Planning Board Member, replacing Ben Magnan who resigned late in 2025.

The floor was then open to the public, Jim Betz, Lori Ziek, and Doug McMullen asked to speak.

Jim B. inquired about the SK stone walls for repair, and highway supervisor Dan said he will have his crew look in to the wall to identify any stones that are in need of repair. Jim questioned the funds in the account that doesn't seem to be gaining any interest, and board agreed to look in to the account and show the spreadsheet doesn't show all the data.

Lori Z asked that Code Enforcer Tomi Tompkins comes to a meeting with a report of his revenue to the town to date. And asked that the board, and Tomi look into the rates of building permits, possibility of more revenue in that area.

Doug McMullen asked about our recording of the meetings, and it was confirmed by Town Supervisor John that the program; OWL will be here by next meeting, and hopes to have it set up in time for July 8th meeting. Doug had an inquiry about the reserve fund balance of \$295,000 in January of 2026 and now its \$180,000, it was explained the funds were used for fire district, and approximately \$93,000 to help keep that Town of Stamford taxes down. Doug asked about the independent audit and its status, John stated he is waiting to hear back from a few independent CPA's and stated that the board will have to give approval to hire and add to budget for reoccurring audits in the future.

Dan Dysenroth came to help with the dedication of the bench from the Howard and Alice Nichols. Each of their tenures spanned decades. Howard was a Town Councilman and Supervisor for the Town of Stamford, retiring in 1993 and his wife, Alice, was a bookkeeper, retiring at the age of 89 in 2019. Together, Alice and Howard worked hard to secure grants through the O'Connor Foundation and the Robinson Broadhurst Foundation to improve and develop our region's beauty.

A MOTION was made by John Kosier and second by Deb Ballard to adjourn the meeting at 6:26pm. ALL AYES votes cast, MOTION carried.
