Kevin Rinehart, Deputy Hwy. Supt. informed the board in 2025 2-way radios will be switched from analog to digital. The company the town deals with, KJBL, can't get a FCC license. The Town of Roxbury is dealing with Tri County Communications in Oneonta. The cost of each radio is approximately \$900. with 13-15 radios needed. After a discussion it was decided Hwy. Supt. Jonathan Ballard should contact Stamford Central School and South Kortright Central School to see when they are going to change radios so the town can communicate with them.
